<u>Bingo:</u> Chair Sears, provided the June report included with the hard copy of these Minutes, and further reported:

- Plans are to reconvene "K T" on September 19, 2024 for another Fall-Spring season.
- Still need some volunteers to assist in event.

Event Coordination: Chair Knight submitted the following report:

- 1. Mary Kay Products is in Hall A on Tuesday evenings thru most of 2024 with a few exception
- 2. The East Side Republican Club (ESRC) is renting Hall B, typically the last Tuesday of each month in 2024 (with a few exceptions)
- 3. The Warbirds are renting Hall A, typically the first Monday of each month starting in February (with a few exception). They will not be having a bartender but will be using the Club room for drinks. They are aware of the new policy on use of the Club room
- 4. No other rentals are scheduled for July 24
- 5. All my rental dates, times, and locations that I have booked so far for 2024 are on the Post calendar
- 6. Hall account: balance as of 6/25/24 is \$2,406.5. The Hall account will be closed the end of this month.
- 7. As a reminder, as was discussed at an EC meeting last year, the "red dot" on the Post calendar indicates a rental
- 8. The use of the Club room bar for Hall rentals appears to be relatively successful so far.

House: Chair Alfieri reported:

- SECO has not yet submitted a proposal to replace/upgrade the security system.
- The quotes to re-pave/repair the parking lot, including compliance with all the township regulations for ramps, bumpers, etc. should be done by mid-August
- Roof leaks are being addressed
- The fryers are cleaned and filtered; the hood will be cleaned next Tuesday
- Still getting miscellaneous stuff at the dumpster; if members drop off, it needs to be Monday nights for pickup Tuesdays (no mattresses, overstuffed chairs, etc.)

<u>Charities</u>, <u>Inc.</u> (C.I.): Wolfangel reported:

- 1) Poppy Days produced net proceeds of about \$5,700.00.
- 2) Lock Box Contribution boxes for both Memorial Poppies and Gifts for Yanks will remain on CR bar year-round to supplement C.I. Budget funding for these two programs.
- 3) Currently working on 2024 -2025 C.I. Budget Proposal which we will make available to Post E.C. upon preliminary draft for any input reference Programs to continue to be supported.

- 4) C.I Treasurer Geil provided necessary 2023-2024 C.I. Program Funding info for Adjutant Carey's CPR Report.
- 5) The following disbursements were made on behalf of Post 318, in closing out the 2023-2024 C.I. Programs Budget: Fisher House \$300 / Honor Flight \$300 / USO \$100. /Yellow ribbon Foundation \$100 / A.L. Legacy Scholarship \$500.
- 6) C.I. Received a \$5,000 donation from Mary Bishop for Save-A-Warrior Program. This will be in addition to C.I.'s planned \$5,000 Save-A-Warrior donation in upcoming 2024-2025 Budget.
- 7) Mary Bishop also made \$2,000 donation to Post 318.
- 8) C.I. Advisory Group member Christine Bishop Moore made a \$100 donation to C.I. Next scheduled C.I. Quarterly Meeting will be in August.
