On June 6, 1944, an Amphibious/Airborne assault took place at Normandy, France. 156,000 troops of the Allied Forces were in the initial attack of German forces by sea and air. This included 54,000 US ground troops, and two airborne divisions. The toughest resistance was met by American forces at Omaha Beach, resulting in 2000 US Troops killed or wounded. The beach was secured on 6/11, with the liberation of France on 8/44. Germany surrendered on 5/8/45. Total of Americans killed 29,000, wounded 106,000.
