Pres. Truman ordered members of the OSS into Viet Nam shortly after WWII, in 1945. In May 1961, Pres. Kennedy ordered 400 Green Berets into Viet Nam, as advisers to the South Vietnamese Army. The US war itself began as a result of the Gulf of Tonkin Resolution in August 1964, when North Vietnamese gunboats attacked a US Destroyer. 82,000 US troops were deployed, but increased to 200, 000. A total of 543,000 US troops were involved during the war. In January of 1973 the US and North Viet Nam signed a final peace agreement, but in 1975 DRV forces captured Saigon. The US suffered 58,281 KIA, with 2646 MIA's at the end of the war. As of 2022, 1582 MIA's still unaccounted for, 1004 in further pursuit, 488 non-recoverable, 90 deferred. The last US troops Left Viet Nam in March, 1973. Post 318 recognizes and appreciates the members of Post 318, who served and sacrificed in the Viet Nam War. Thank you all.

ODVS Announces Sunset of Ohio Veterans Bonus

On Aug., 30, 2021 — the United States officially ceased its military involvement in Afghanistan. As a result, the Ohio Veterans Bonus program associated with the Afghanistan Conflict, which the Ohio Department of Veterans Services (ODVS) administers, is nearing its completion.

Through the support of **Ohio Governor Mike DeWine** and the State Legislature, a \$9.5 million measure was included in the state's recently enacted biennial budget in order to sustain the program, which will sunset in one year. The Office of Budget and Management (OBM) authorized that transfer to our agency.

These funds will ensure that ODVS can make a rigorous final push to pay every eligible veteran — including those who may have been denied payment because of correctable technicalities or other impediments. The money total is based on Department of Defense deployment figures and the number of applicants and payouts that already have been made to Ohio veterans.

The Ohio Veterans Bonus program offers a bonus for those who served in the U.S. Armed Forces after October 7, 2001. Once a veteran has received \$500 for service anywhere in the world or \$1,000 for service in a designated country, or the maximum \$1,500 bonus, the veteran is not eligible for additional funds, even if they served in multiple conflicts. **Those service members who completed their deployments in Afghanistan and have not yet applied for the Ohio Veterans Bonus can do so up until Aug. 30, 2024.**
